Eligibility Requirements:

- Matriculated at the University of Maine (Orono)
- Enrolled in a degree leading to teacher certification and will continue enrollment as an undergraduate in 2008-09
- Sophomore standing or higher
- Minimum GPA: 3.00 or greater
- Demonstrated financial need through the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

To Apply:

- Complete the 2008-09 *Galen Cole Family Foundation Education Scholarship Application Form*
- Include a typed statement (500 words or less) that addresses your career goals and willingness to serve in an approved *Cole Land Transportation Museum* education program (www.colemuseum.org)
- Submit proof of good academic standing (*Transcript*)
- Submit the *Cole Scholarship Financial Need* statement

Note: Scholarship recipients are expected to sign the Galen Cole Family Foundation Education Scholarship Agreement form. (See Conditions for Acceptance)

For priority consideration, please submit your completed scholarship application by **March 28, 2008**.
