The Project COLE (Collection of Learning Enrichments) team from Bangor Christian School has developed a Transportation Kit for PreK-Grade 1 students. The complete kit comes in a large tote filled with almost everything needed to complete the lesson plans which are outlined in the three ring binder. The binder includes Teacher Information, Overview, Objectives, Lesson Plans, Reproducibles, Learning Results, Assessment Sheets, Inventory, Sources & Resources, and Teacher Comments.

The lesson plans include: Introduction, Transportation Now & Then, Military Vehicles, Construction Vehicles, Farm Vehicles, Trains, and Transportation Parade and Wrap Up Day.

The Community Helpers Kit is appropriate for instruction either in the fall or the spring. The lessons are easily adjusted to fit the students' ability levels. Because it culminates with a field trip to the Cole Land Transportation Museum, teachers are encouraged to consider dates the museum is open.

This kit includes an abundance of hands-on materials. Teachers should allow time to look through the kit before teaching it to a class.

This unit will take +/- 2 weeks.
