Eligibility Requirements:

- Matriculated at the University of Maine in Orono.
- Enrolled in a degree leading to teacher certification and will continue enrollment as an undergraduate in 2011-12.
- Sophomore standing or higher.
- Minimum GPA: 3.00 or greater.
- Demonstrated financial need through the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

To Apply:

- Complete the 2011-12 Galen Cole Family Foundation Education Scholarship Application form.
- Include a typed statement (500 words or less) that addresses your career goals and willingness to serve in an approved Cole Land Transportation Museum education program (www.colemuseum.org).
- Submit proof of good academic standing (Transcript).
- Submit the Cole Scholarship Financial Need statement.

Note: Scholarship recipients are expected to sign the Galen Cole Family Foundation Education Scholarship Agreement form. (See Conditions of for Acceptance).

For priority consideration, please submit your completed scholarship application by March 28th, 2011.

- Enroll full-time (minimum of 12 credit hours) each semester during the **2011-12** academic year.
- Participate in a *Cole Land Transportation Museum* (CLTM) volunteer program.

Options include:

 - ★ Partner with a cooperating Maine educator on the creation of a Veterans’ Memorial

 - ★ Attend KIDS Consortium’s Professional Development Training
 - ★ Create an original service-learning project in conjunction with the CLTM
