

Transportation Cost Assistance

The Galen Cole Family Foundation and the Cole Land Transportation Museum makes available a **Transportation Cost Assistance** program for all student field trips where it is warranted by the circumstances of the individual classroom.

This program has been designed to help schools with a high percentage of students that qualify for free and reduced lunches. However, other schools are eligible, depending on the availability of funds.

In order to be considered for **Transportation Cost Assistance**, each school must fulfill a minimum 2.25 hour time commitment at the Museum. If actual time commitments are not met, funding will be reduced. Unavoidable delays such as road construction, breakdowns, and illness will be taken into consideration.

The **Transportation Cost Assistance** Program is limited to a maximum of \$1.50 per round trip mile plus \$50 for each full bus load of students (based on 50 students). Partial busloads may be approved for schools which do not have the capability of filling the bus, or first-time schools.

The **Transportation Cost Assistance** Program's reimbursement is not available if funding has been provided for Patriotic Grant, Project Graduation, or Reading Recovery.
